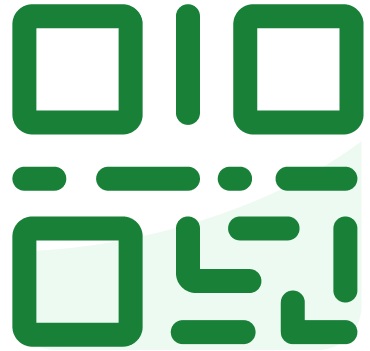

Objectives

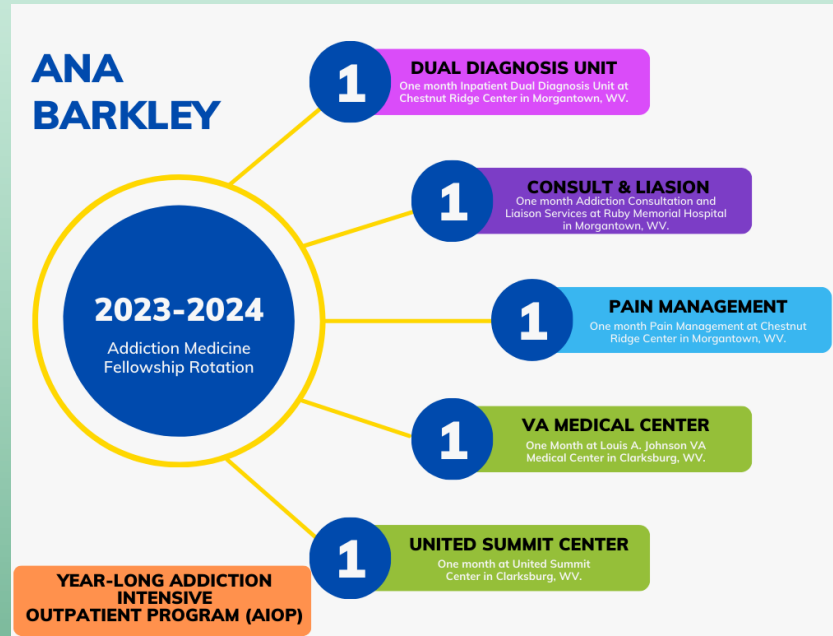

Midterm Reporting

Approx. 1/2 through training
